<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Students may fulfill this requirement once the language prerequisites have been met. Students must take 8 total credits of Biblical Studies (NT or OT prefix). This total must include NT500 and OT500. Any NT or OT credits earned over the 8 required will be applied to the student's general elective requirement.
